---Please support the **Northwest Catholic Magazine** – *the official publication of the Archdiocese of Seattle*. Its mission is to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ to Catholics in Western Washington, to teach, inspire and form disciples who know the Lord and live their faith to the full.

There will be a special collection at all Masses this weekend. A flyer was included in the bulletin last weekend. Thank you for your generous donation.

---The Gospel reading on this **fourth-week in Ordinary Time** is Jesus taught "**with authority**," that is, he was the *author* of what he said; it never became his habit to quote rabbis and other authors, as the scribes used to do. What he said, if we are to guess from all the gospels, went straight to the hearts of his listeners. His teaching had authority in a further sense: *it made things happen*. He cast out demons. But when Jesus preaches – "*the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have good news brought to them*".

These were of the **Messianic age**: in other words, they were indications that Jesus was indeed the long-awaited one, **the Messiah**. Jesus did not disrespect the Scriptures; he used them for their intended purpose, to set people free and especially, not to tie them up.

TRUE PROPHETS - In Deuteronomy today we hear that God's very words will fill the mouth of a true prophet, but a false prophet will, in a manner of speaking, put mere mortal words into God's mouth. In Mark's Gospel, we see Jesus teaching and healing as a true prophet, one filled with the authority of God's own voice. The whole history of our church is filled with both true and false prophets. Some false prophets were extremely popular and quite well-versed in scripture, and even held positions of authority. But in today's Gospel we learn that Jesus' fame spread because he taught with authority; he wasn't an authority because he was popular or famous. Elsewhere, we also learn from him, in his desert temptation confrontations with Satan, that anyone can quote scripture, even against God's purposes. Today we hear that his authority was not like that of the scribes, who held the official positions of religious authority in his day. Our work is to do our best to discern the true prophets in our midst, and to be true prophets as well. The psalmist tells us how to do this: by not hardening our hearts when God speaks.
